This can be done on your own or in connection with timing or events in your Chapter or Section. Keep track of the amount of time you either fly an aircraft or ride along in an aircraft.

All participants must have proof of aircraft hull and liability insurance that covers all those aboard the aircraft. Check www.ninety-nines.org/breastcancercure/ for additional details. Experimental or homebuilt aircraft, helicopters, and balloons are not eligible to participate.
