NEW ENGLAND NINETY-NINES SCHOLARSHIPS AVAILABLE

The Eastern New England Chapter of The Ninety-Nines (International Organization of Women Pilots) announces three 2012 scholarships available for women and men studying for a career in aviation, or seeking to earn pilot certificates.

The Eastern New England scholarships for 2012 are: 1) the Katharine Barr Honorary Scholarship for \$1500 (open to both women and men), 2) the William Bridge Scholarship for \$1500, and 3) the Ann Wood Kelly Memorial Scholarship for \$1500 (both open to a woman with at least a private pilot certificate).

The New England Section of the Ninety-Nines offers a scholarship in memory of New Hampshire aviator Shirley Mahn, who died in 1975 at the controls of her Piper Aztec. The Shirley Mahn Memorial Scholarship for \$1500 will be awarded in 2012.

All scholarships require a New England connection—the applicant must be either a resident of one of the six New England states, or studying in New England.
