Marilyn Alderman Scholarship Criteria

- 1. Applicant must be female.
- 2. Scholarship recipient must become a member of the Delaware Chapter of the 99's prior to monies being awarded. Membership application forms can be found at our website: http://www.ninety-nines.org under the drop-down list *Join 99s*.
- 3. Applicant must have soloed at the time of application.
- 4. Applicant must be working towards a sport pilot or higher rating.
- 5. Applicant must sign the application, and if under 18, parent(s) must also sign.
- 6. The award must be used for flight time rating specified in the application.
- 7. Applicant must submit a Letter of Recommendation from her flight instructor.
- 8. Applicant must submit a letter explaining goals and interests.

Expectations for Scholarship Winner

If not currently a Delaware Chapter 99's Member, winner must join the DE Chapter 99's for a minimum of one (1) year after the scholarship is awarded.

Winner is required to attend at least two (2) Delaware Chapter meetings.

The award money must be used within one year (365 days) of presentation. All unused portions will be refunded to the Delaware Chapter.

On completion of the use of the scholarship money, winners are required to present a report in writing or verbally to the Chapter regarding their accomplishments.
