BERNICE BARRIS SCHOLARSHIP OF THE LAKE ERIE CHAPTER OF THE NINETY-NINES, INC.

This scholarship honors the Lake Erie Chapter and International Ninety-Nines, Inc. member Bernice Barris, for over 50 years of dedicated service and support of women pilots.

The Lake Erie Chapter of the Ninety-Nines, Inc. is offering up to a \$1,000.00 scholarship award to be used for initial or advanced flight training. The scholarship will be awarded annually. The scholarship awards can occasionally be increased to \$2000. upon approval by the Lake Erie Chapter membership.

Scholarship Requirements: Applicants must be a current member of the International Ninety-Nines, Inc. and must have belonged to a Ninety-Nines chapter in the State of Ohio for at least 1 year or lived in Northwestern PA and been a Lake Erie Chapter member as of the application date. A minimum of 20 hours of flight time is required. A prior awardee may apply for higher-level training in subsequent years.

This award must be used for the purpose stated in the application. The name and address of the school where instruction will be completed must be listed on the application and signed by a school representative or CFI/CFII (FAA-certified flight instructor). Flight training must be completed within two calendar years from the date awarded.

The scholarship will be awarded annually by the Lake Erie Chapter Scholarship Committee, in its sole discretion, based on its evaluation of applications received. If no award is made, funds will be held until the following year.

The scholarship awardee is required to attend at least 4 Lake Erie Chapter meetings and/or sponsored events each year during the 2-year term of the scholarship.

Other Information:

Scholarship funds are disbursed in one of two ways:

- 1. Direct Payment. Direct payment will be made to instructor/flight school providing flight instruction services.
- 2. Reimbursement. Scholarship funds may only be applied to training that is completed after scholarship is awarded. Funds must not be used to offset costs incurred prior to the date of the scholarship award. Reimbursement may be made to the scholarship recipient, provided that the recipient includes supporting documentation from instructor/flight school regarding the cost of service to complete the training activity. The applicant must provide copies of logbook pages of flights for the training activities, receipts for services provided by the instructor/flight school showing fees paid, flight instructor's certificate number, and contact information for flight instructor or flight school to the Lake Erie Chapter 99s scholarship chair.
