ADDITIONAL APPLICANT ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

1. <u>FLIGHT CURRENCY</u>: At time of application, applicant must be current and qualified as pilot **only if** course includes flight training, i.e., must provide evidence of current flight review, competency or proficiency check, or equivalent.

Note: Landing / instrument currency not required.

- 2. <u>COLLEGE ENROLLMENT</u>: At time of application, applicant must be currently enrolled in an aviation or aerospace-related degree or certificate program at any accredited college or university.
- 3. <u>ACADEMIC STANDING</u>: Associate's, Bachelor's or higher degree students must have cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 or better on a 4.0 scale, or equivalent.

- Establish financial need.
- Be an active, participating Ninety-Nines member.
- Be active in aviation extracurricular activities.
- Demonstrate high academic achievement.
- Have reachable, realistic goals.
